



The grid-in response area is a 9x9 grid. The columns are numbered 1 through 9 at the top. The rows are numbered 1 through 9 on the left. The grid is divided into four quadrants by a vertical line between columns 4 and 5, and a horizontal line between rows 4 and 5. The numbers in the grid are as follows:

The numbers in the grid are: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9. The numbers are placed in the grid as follows: 1 is in row 9, column 5; 2 is in row 3, column 3; 3 is in row 2, column 1; 4 is in row 2, column 6; 5 is in row 6, column 8; 6 is in row 9, column 5; 7 is in row 5, column 2; 8 is in row 7, column 3; 9 is in row 2, column 2.
