- Row 9:** 8 at (9,2), 7 at (9,3), dot at (9,4), dot at (9,5), dot at (9,6), dot at (9,7), dot at (9,8), dot at (9,9), dot at (9,10).
- Row 10:** 8 at (10,2), 7 at (10,3), dot at (10,4), dot at (10,5), dot at (10,6), dot at (10,7), dot at (10,8), dot at (10,9), dot at (10,10).
