- Path 2: 9 (C6) -> 2 (C5) -> 7 (C7)
- Path 3: 6 (C3) -> 1 (C4) -> 7 (C5) -> 6 (C6) -> 7 (C7)
- Path 4: 7 (C3) -> 6 (C4) -> 4 (C5) -> 2 (C6) -> 3 (C7)
- Path 5: 4 (C3) -> 7 (C4) -> 6 (C5) -> 2 (C6) -> 3 (C7)
- Path 6: 2 (C1) -> 7 (C3) -> 6 (C4) -> 5 (C5) -> 8 (C6) -> 4 (C7)
