- Bottom-right quadrant: A path from (4,4) to (4,5) to (5,5) to (5,6) to (6,6) to (6,5) to (6,4) to (6,3) to (6,2) to (6,1) to (5,1) to (5,2) to (5,3) to (5,4) to (5,5) to (5,6) to (4,6) to (4,5) to (4,4).
