The geometric shapes are as follows:

- Top-Left Quadrant (Rows 1-3, Columns 1-3):** A shape starting at (1,1), going right to (1,2), down to (2,2), left to (2,1), and down to (3,1).
- Top-Right Quadrant (Rows 1-3, Columns 4-6):** A shape starting at (1,4), going right to (1,5), down to (2,5), left to (2,4), and down to (3,4).
- Middle-Left Quadrant (Rows 4-6, Columns 1-3):** A shape starting at (4,1), going right to (4,2), down to (5,2), left to (5,1), and down to (6,1).
- Middle-Right Quadrant (Rows 4-6, Columns 4-6):** A shape starting at (4,4), going right to (4,5), down to (5,5), left to (5,4), and down to (6,4).
- Bottom-Left Quadrant (Rows 4-6, Columns 1-3):** A shape starting at (4,3), going right to (4,4), down to (5,4), left to (5,3), and down to (6,3).
- Bottom-Right Quadrant (Rows 4-6, Columns 4-6):** A shape starting at (4,6), going right to (4,5), down to (5,5), left to (5,4), and down to (6,4).
