- Puzzle 8 (Bottom Middle):** Mines at (1,3) and (2,1). Numbers: (1,1)=7, (1,2)=4, (1,3)=8, (2,2)=6, (2,3)=5.
- Puzzle 9 (Bottom Right):** Mines at (1,2) and (2,3). Numbers: (1,1)=2, (1,2)=4, (2,1)=7, (2,2)=5.
