Puzzle 6 (Middle Right): Circle at (2,3) has lines to (2,2) and (3,3). Number 5 is at (2,2), 1 is at (2,3), and 2 is at (3,3).

Puzzle 7 (Bottom Left): Circle at (2,2) has lines to (2,1) and (2,3). Number 3 is at (2,1), 9 is at (2,2), and 2 is at (2,3).

Puzzle 8 (Bottom Middle): Circle at (2,1) has lines to (2,2) and (2,3). Number 5 is at (2,2), 2 is at (2,3), and 8 is at (3,3).

Puzzle 9 (Bottom Right): Circle at (2,2) has lines to (2,1) and (2,3). Number 2 is at (2,1), 7 is at (2,2), and 8 is at (2,3).
